

Heading to China

Seven affiliated teaching hospitals and 123 clinical training establishments with 7,000 bed capacity are unbelievable facilities for a medical college in India but Liaoning Medical University (LMU) in China offers such facilities. Jinzhou city in a 200-acre campus it has the distinction of being the first among the Chinese medical universities to introduce English medium teaching for foreign students, said Raja Ram of Medico Abroad introducing the university to students.

He said the departments are headed by professors with Ph.Ds from abroad and national awardee laureates, and score high scientific index. Most

of the faculty is US, UK trained and proficient in English.

The orientation saw students understanding the academic schedule, curriculum, teaching methodology, strict laws in China and life in China for a foreign student. Parents also attend the meeting where they got a brief on the travel arrangements. Students also got laptops loaded with study material and also USMLE material for their future.
