To mention a few examples,

- a) In the case of 2012 Batch students who have not received their MCI Eligibility Certificates, few members of the Association travelled to Delhi and represented the matter with the officials of Medical Council of India, resulting in successful issuance of certificates to almost 70% of the students, and the process is still on for the balance students.
- b) On exchange of communication from university relating to delayed fee payments and absence to classes which bars our students from attending semester exams, the President and Secretary of the Association personally called and advised parents accordingly on the guidelines and ensured timely compliance, thus saving majority of students from disciplinary action.
- c) Regarding specific requests of room change or class change from Indian lecturer, the university sought recommendations/ approval from the Association which was promptly attended by them in the benefit of students.

Thus, as you see, the dedicated members of the Association are not only playing monumental role but also assuming responsibilities which rightfully deserves loud applause and commendation from all of you.
